

5 problem solvers, from sweet melons to sweet shoes

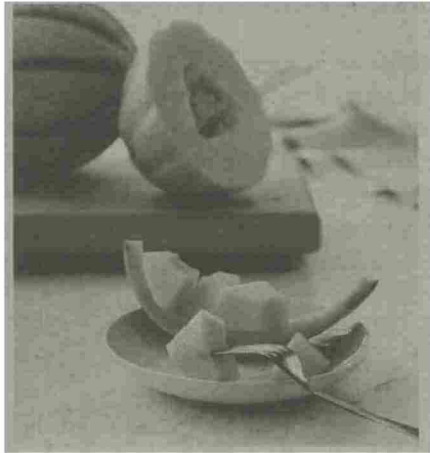


Nylon bag, \$5

Screwdriver, \$25

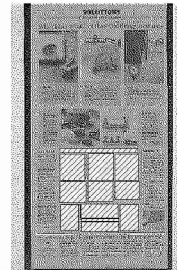
Problem: Every DIY project calls for a different screwdriver.
