Dulcinea Rosso Bruno, printed on the box's label, meant nothing, so we were surprised when inside we found several mesh bags of tomatoes – **brown tomatoes.**

Maybe you've seen them in the groceries. The Rosso Bruno tomato is ready to eat when it turns brown with hints of green. The greenhouse-grown tomatoes – \$3.99/pound or a two-count bag for \$2.29 – come from British Columbia and California.

With all the homegrown tomatoes available, this time of year isn't the best for taste-testing a shipped-in tomato. But the Rosso Brunos have a fresh, rich tomato taste. In February, they're going to taste mighty good.
